FLY-IN NEWS:

Plans are progressing very well for the National Fly-In. The following is a list of important items concerning the Fly-In:

7. THE UNIVERSITY CAFETERIAS will be available to us each day for breakfast from 7:30 to 9:00 and for dinner from 4:30 til 6:15. You will find the University food very good and very reasonably priced.




